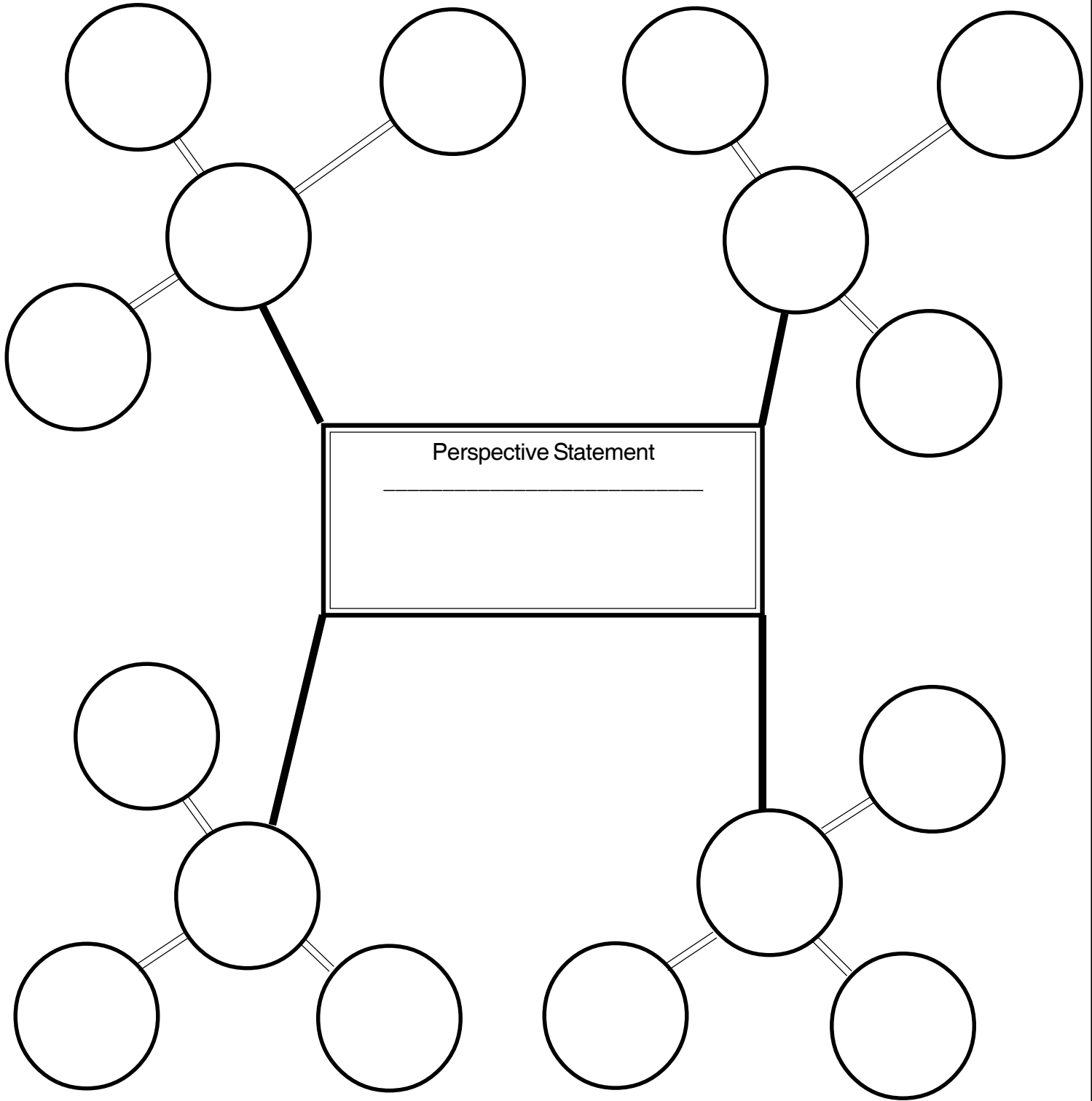


# Impact Wheel

- In the first-order circles, state four consequences that might follow directly from the perspective. (There may be more than 4; add other circles.)
- In second-order circles, name the effects of each of the first-order consequences.
- Write a three- or four-sentence scenario by combining the effects and consequences you have projected.
- Use these scenarios to develop a position on the issue in Step 5.
