

## AAFCS Pre-Professional Assessment and Certification (Pre-PAC) Technical Requirements

**Hardware Requirements:** None

**Software:** Web-based/Internet/ASP

- Compatible browsers include: Internet Explorer 6, 7, 8 and Firefox 3.5 and higher
- Flash
- Adobe Reader

### Ports or IP Addresses

- PORT = 80/443 (http ports) is required to support http and https.
- AAFCS recommends trying to access and log into the assessment website before testing to ensure that the Test Site's network doesn't try to filter or block the assessment website. If the site is blocked, forward the following URLs/domains to your technology department to be sure these domains, that are required for delivering AAFCS exams, are added to the approved list of domains.
